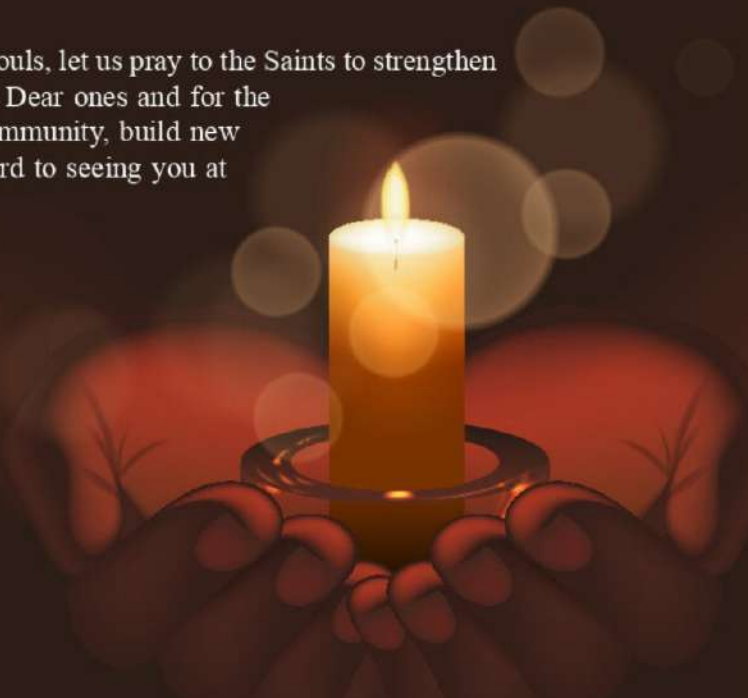
"The Henpecked Morning" event, where men took over the kitchen, was a fun way to celebrate camaraderie and culinary talents, with active participation across all age groups.
