TABLE TENNIS

TT Ranking Competition 2026

The time is ripe for a Ranking Competition of all our TT players in the club. The last competition only did a broad grading of all players into A-D. Since however, many new players have joined and most of the existing players have greatly improved their game. Hence a need to do a fresh RANKING competition. There will be separate ranks for Men and Women.

Ranking players helps when conducting a league, where team owners need to know the caliber of the player they are including in their group during the auction. It also helps when choosing players to represent the club in Inter Club tournaments.

We plan to have this tournament in February/March during Lent where we anticipate that the ball room will be available for a longer duration as this tournament may go on for 2-3 weekends (Sat and Sunday). Note that this is a serious tournament and will require commitment from players to play all their rounds over the 2/3 weekends so that there is a lot of accuracy in the ranking. If a player is a no-show, it can skewer the rankings.

Note: The format for the tournament will be announced after registrations closes, as it depends on the number of participants.

The charges for participation will be Rs. 200 per player. There is no age bar (although we feel that very young players should not participate but come to watch and learn). Players will need to register in the google form and this amount will be deducted after the tournament. Cancellations 48 hrs before the tournament starts are permitted. Only Tea/Coffee/Biscuits will be served during the tournament. Balls will be provided by the club.

TT Tournament rules & guidelines

- Matches on Saturday will start at 4.30 pm and may go on till 9 pm. Matches on Sunday will start at 10:00 am. All players who have registered are requested to assemble in the ball room. We will be using 4 tables so that maximum games can be played at the same time
- A win gets 2 points
- Each game is 11 points and matches will be the BEST OF 3
- After each match, the referee will hand over the scores for data entry so that the software can then allot the next table
- There are many matches to be played, therefore players are requested to be prompt and alert when their match is announced
- Referees' decision is final in case of any dispute
- This being a serious tournament, follow the rules such as tossing the ball on the serve. You can lose points if the ball is not tossed after the first warning
- Kindly bring your own bats to play. Wear non-skid shoes, as the floor is tiled and may be slippery. Balls are provided by the club
- Do not wear white shirts as it obstructs the view of the ball

Every year Catholic Club Orphan's Trust (CCOT) organizes a Medical Camp to provide accessible healthcare to underprivileged children and promote preventive health measures. All children were screened for various health parameters, like general wellness, nutrition status and early detection of potential health concerns. This proactive screening ensures timely intervention and creates a solid foundation for the children's overall growth and development. The camp was led by Dr. Bobby, who brought in a dedicated team of doctors. This ensured that each child received individual attention and proper guidance. The volunteers played a vital role in coordinating registration, assisting doctors and providing health education to the children and their caregivers.

Following the initial medical camp, a focussed post-medical treatment session was conducted on the 24th at the RTC Girls' Home, specifically addressing the health concerns identified during the camp, particularly in the OBG (Obstetrics & Gynecology) category. Dr. Sunitha led this session, providing her expertise to ensure that the students received proper follow-up care. During the visit, she examined over 12 students who had been flagged for further attention, assessing each case individually to understand their specific health needs. Based on her examinations, Dr. Sunitha offered personalized consultations, educating the students about their conditions and advising them on necessary precautions and lifestyle adjustments to improve their well-being. She also prescribed medications tailored to each student's health issues, ensuring that they would receive appropriate treatment promptly. This follow-up initiative was crucial in bridging the gap between initial screening and ongoing care,
